UPDATES

- On July 20, 2020 Council extended by ordinance our Local Disaster Order until December 31, 2020 and may change depending on the Governor's orders. City Hall doors are open with restrictions. Only 2 persons will be permitted into the lobby to maintain 6 feet distancing. It will be required to wear a facial mask when entering the building for the safety of our employees and citizens. Payments can still be made online, by mail and night drop.

 - Our Children's Park will remain closed, apart from the walking trail, until further notice. Curfew is still in place from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m.
