**San Patricio County's COVID-19 Situation Report**

Public Health Preparedness Department reported **thirty (30) new cases today** that are all under investigation and our hospitalization count is zero. The **County's confirmed COVID-19 case count will move to 935**. The **County's active case count moves up to 239** as this count also denotes that **twenty-seven (27) individuals were released from COVID-19 protocol**. **DSHS is reporting twenty (20) COVID-19 fatalities for San Patricio County at the time of this release**. The County's completed tests count is 2675. The County's immediate risk of transmission is intermediate.

**Reminder:** Isolation is required after being diagnosed with COVID-19 in order to slow the spread of this virus. The CDC recommends isolation be maintained for at least 10 days after illness onset AND at least 3 days (72 hours) after recovery. Illness onset is the date symptoms began and recovery is the resolution of fever with improvement of other symptoms.
