**San Patricio County's COVID-19 Situation Report**

Public Health Preparedness Department reported **sixty-seven (67) new cases today** that are all under investigation and our hospitalization count is now one (1). The **County's confirmed COVID-19 case count will move to 624**. The County's active case count moves up to **325 as this count also denotes that eight (8) individuals were released from COVID-19 protocol**. The County's completed tests count is 2136. The County's immediate risk of transmission is intermediate.
