San Patricio County's COVID-19 Situation Report

Public Health Preparedness Manager Clara Rieder reported **three (3) new cases today** that are under investigation. **The County's active case count moves up to twenty-five (25)** and there is no change to our **Recovered total of 37**. The County's **confirmed COVID-19 case count is now 62** and our completed tests count is 761. The immediate risk of transmission in the County is minimal.
