**San Patricio County's COVID-19 Situation Report**

The County's **confirmed COVID-19 case count is now 80** as Public Health Preparedness Manager Clara Rieder reported **fourteen (14) new cases** received in the last four days. The breakdown of their Transmission is indicated below. The **County's active case count moves up to thirty-four (34)** and our Recovered total also moves up as six (6) individuals were released from COVID-19 protocol. The County's completed tests count is 821. The immediate risk of transmission in the County is minimal.
