PERMANENT RAMP CLOSURES SET IN GREGORY ON US 181 PROJECT

US 181 northbound entrance and exit ramps north of FM 3239/Buddy Ganem Drive to close permanently

October 28, 2021

GREGORY – The next phase of construction work on the US 181 Gregory improvement project will require the permanent closure on Friday, Oct. 29, of the entrance and exit ramps on US 181 northbound just north of FM 3239/Buddy Ganem Drive.

The existing US 181 northbound exit ramp to Sinton will be temporarily reopened at this time.

Motorists who normally use the northbound entrance ramp to US 181 at FM 2329 will travel on the US 181 northbound frontage road to the SH 35 frontage road to access the northbound SH 35 entrance ramp. Travelers wanting to access US 181 northbound to Sinton will continue on the frontage road toward Sunset Road.

Motorists who normally use the US 181 northbound exit ramp to access La Quinta Terminal/Kay Bailey Hutchison Road area will use the FM 3239/Buddy Ganem Drive/Northshore Boulevard exit and proceed through the traffic signal at the intersection while the new exit ramp is being constructed.

The existing US 181 northbound Sinton exit ramp will be temporarily reopened for traffic heading north on US 181 to Sinton/Taft during construction of the new ramps.

Motorists may experience delays and are urged to slow down in the work zone, follow all traffic control devices and pay close attention to traffic signals when traveling through the FM 3239 intersection.

All work is weather permitting.
